SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

Since the second century, the Church has been almost exclusively made up of Gentiles—non-Jews—a situation that none of the Apostles or New Testament writers could have imagined. Israel had always expected the Gentile nations to come to their God but thought they would do so by way of Judaism. The Jewish people knew that the savior was promised to the world, but they assumed that Gentiles would become Jewish in order to know God through Christ. Instead, Gentiles came to know God through Jesus, becoming Christians from their Gentile state instead of becoming Jewish first.

God does not desire for us to be like servants; we are not blindly following orders he gave to us. Instead, Jesus calls us his friends and expects us to love one another in the same fashion.
