SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (CORPUS CHRISTI)

On This Solemnity of Corpus Christi, we delve into Christ's willingness to sacrifice himself for others. Blood is life. The people of ancient Israel knew that. It is fitting, then, that Jesus talks about his blood as the blood of the covenant. The blood of the old covenant, says the Letter to the Hebrews, sanctified the body; the blood of the new covenant sanctifies the mind and heart forever.
