### FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

After Jesus' unfortunate experience in his hometown, he sends his disciples out to preach repentance, cast out demons, and anoint and heal the sick. Jesus' injunction to travel light appears to serve several purposes. The Apostles need to move quickly and easily from place to place. The instructions to carry a staff and wear sandals are reminiscent of the instructions Moses gave for the Passover meal. Going out without food, baggage, or money forces the Apostles to depend on the hospitality of strangers and, ultimately, on God. Finally, perhaps mindful of his own experience, Jesus urges the Apostles to leave any place that rejects them. Shaking off the dust is thought to be a Jewish custom that allows one to go on without dwelling on past troubles.

When Mary appeared to the children at Fatima, she told them "tell everybody that God gives graces through the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Tell them to ask graces from her, and that the Heart of Jesus wishes to be venerated together with the Immaculate Heart of Mary.
