### TWENTY-NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

The first reading is probably familiar to us as the Good Friday reading about the suffering servant of God. The prophecy of a servant who would redeem Israel through suffering is unique among prophetic books. Those who witnessed the crucifixion and Resurrection of Jesus Christ were trying to describe something they had never experienced. Early Christian communities found the most apt descriptions for Jesus in the words and prophecies of the Old Testament. For them, Jesus was the fulfillment of those Scriptures because what they read there fit their experience of Jesus so closely. The words of Isaiah help us understand the object of our belief; in turn, our belief provides some illumination on the words spoken so long before Jesus.
