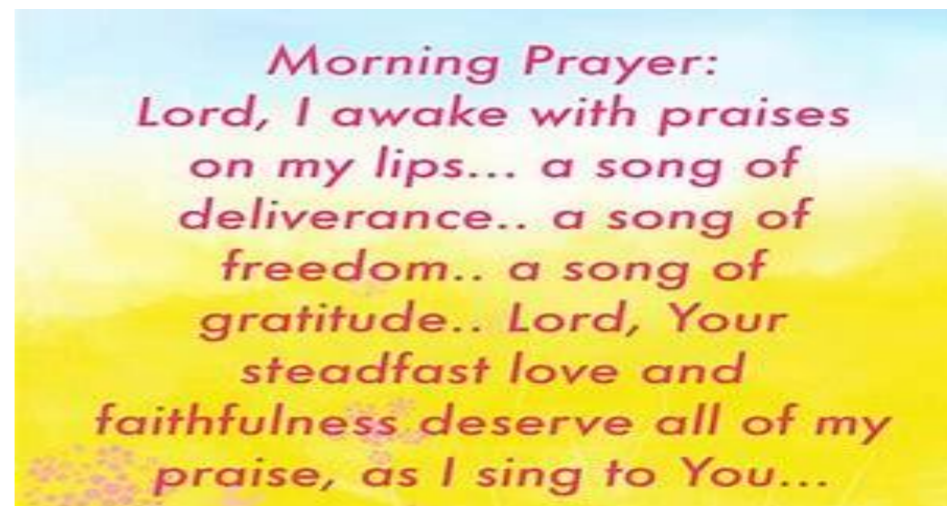
St. Anthony Parish and Finance Council meeting Thursday, June 23rd following Mass.
