#### The Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary

The councils feel that adding acoustic panels would take away from the beauty of our church, so it has been decided not to add them at this time.

Please note that the sound is much clearer in the front of the church, so if the sound is an issue for you, please consider sitting toward the front of the church.


#### **Totus Tuus**
