### 14<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

The Gospel reminds us of the high level of commitment in Jesus' community of disciples. In this particular version of the "sending of the disciples" story, found only in Luke, Jesus sends out seventy-two disciples, in addition, to the twelve apostles seen in the other Gospel accounts. The scant rations these apostles take shows their trust in the nearness of God's Kingdom and models the life of self-denial that permeated Jesus' teachings. Jesus sends the disciples out "like lambs among wolves" (Lk 10:3) the work of discipleship is deeply challenging. And yet, today's readings keep pulling us back to joy. We hear over and over: "rejoice." In the face of challenges, God will always be there to console us, comfort us, and bring us everlasting peace.

**St. Lawrence** The acoustic atmosphere of a Gothic style church is an important part of the cultural heritage. Our church was built prior to the use of a sound system, and was designed to carry the sound throughout the church. The high ceilings, the plaster walls, and the columns all affect how the sound carries. After many professional evaluations of the St. Lawrence Church sound system, it has been determined that only option we have to improve the acoustics in the church would require installing acoustic panels throughout the church. The councils feel that adding acoustic panels would take away from the beauty of our church, so it has been decided not to add them at this time.

Please note that the sound is much clearer in the front of the church, so if the sound is an issue for you, please consider sitting toward the front of the church.
