18th Sunday in Ordinary Time

“Thus it will be for all who store up treasure for themselves but are not rich in what matters to God.” And what is it that matters to God? Today’s second reading answers the question that arises from today’s Gospel. What matters to God is that we become like him, that we “put on the new self, which is being renewed ...in the image of its Creator.” What matters is that we do what he does, that is, that we give ourselves away in love. Yet what matters to God is that we are giving ourselves away at every moment, to the unborn as well as to the born, and to the weak as well as to the strong.

As the Gospel indicates, judgment can come at any moment; our opportunity to give life to others can cease at any moment. “To whom will all this piled-up wealth of yours go?” In that Culture of Life, we are secure at every moment in knowing that we simply seek to give ourselves away, that others may live.

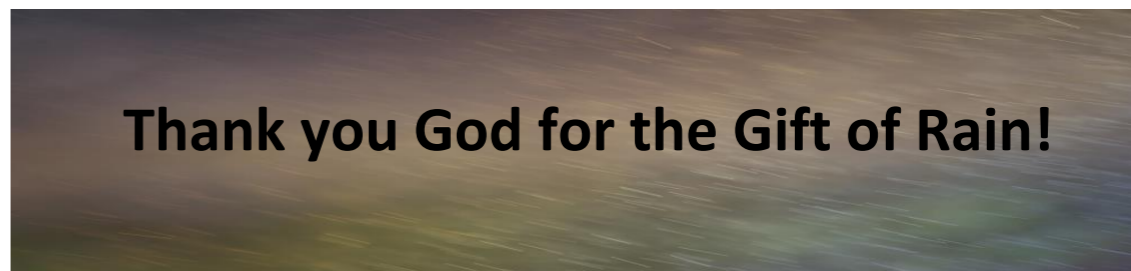
St. Anthony Annual Truck and Tractor Pull will be Saturday, August 20th. Starting time is 7:00 pm at the St. Anthony Community Park.

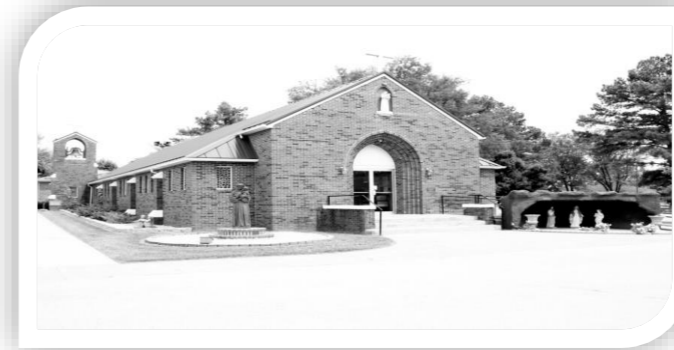
