St. Anthony Parish Council Meeting (Sept. 15): ●Reminder of the Welcome Party for Father Aubuchon this Sunday, the 18th; discussed details ●Discussed finished bathroom project at the Hall; painted, new floorcovering & toilets reset ●Tuck pointing on Hall completed; cost \$10,500 ●Work on sewer line, septic tank pumped out, repair of leak at well house and further checking of sewer lines and possibility of trees needing to be removed that are interfering with those lines were discussed ●Instead of guttering at the front of the hall, a buried pipe will carry the water away from the building ●Parish Council will continue the Mass count on Sundays & Holy days ●CCD students will participate in Mass the 3rd Sunday every month ●We will purchase a new vacuum cleaner for the Hall ●Donations for tables for the Hall were generous; some old tables will be placed at the Pavilion, some donated to the Park ●railings will be installed on both sides of the stairs coming out of the kitchen on the back side of the hall ●Financial report from July 1 through September 15th was presented ●Four applicants for Parish secretary/bookkeeper; interviews Sept. 18 & 19 ●Approximately 129 Parishioners are Virtus trained and can volunteer at the Fall Supper; Fall Supper will occur with modifications needed depending on the number closer to the time ●Cross on the top of Church has been cleaned, stabilized and painted ●Inquiries will be made for taking out the dead trees on the Parish Property ●Parish Christmas Party will be held on the evening of December 11th.
