### 30<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke often contrasts Pharisees and tax collectors. The two groups act as ironic foils with Luke's view of God's plan for salvation. The initial chapters of Luke's account explain that Jesus' ministry changes the world fundamentally; the poor will be blessed while the rich suffer loss; mighty Rome will fall and the lowly, occupied people of Israel will rise. But this inversion is not only political and social but also theological. Those thought to stand at the pinnacle of righteousness are exposed as disobedient, while impure, lowly outsiders are invited to God's kingdom. So it is with this Pharisee and tax collector. What does this mean? Well, we are meant to feel the distance between the Pharisee and the tax collector and

recognize the tax collector spoke to God as best he could. In Jesus' view, the man (the tax collector) went home in right relationship with God as he recognized his flaws before God and asked for forgiveness, something the Pharisee could not do.

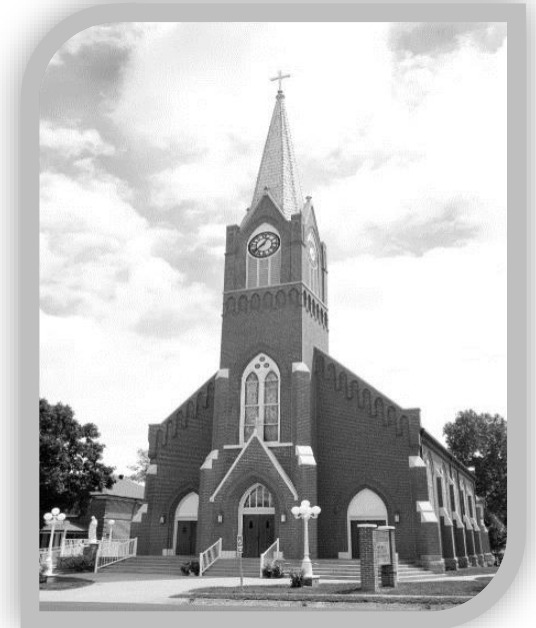
