Sunday, March 12, 2023 – Third Sunday of Lent

Today and for the next two Sundays, we will meet three fascinating Gospel characters; the Samaritan woman, the man born blind, and Lazarus. They will show us, those of us already baptized and those preparing for baptism at the Easter Vigil (the elect), how Jesus is constantly transforming us. All the Scriptures on these days present images of baptism and conversion. Specifically in today's Gospel, Jesus talks to the Samaritan woman. Although the story begins with Jesus' thirst, it is the woman who is refreshed! She enters the story as a catechumen and becomes an evangelist, bearer of Good News!




