Sunday, March 26, 2023 – Fifth Sunday of Lent

In today's first reading, the propher Ezekiel delivers God's words to his covenant people, using a graphic metaphor to illustrate God's desire and power to give them life. The graves of the dead will be opened and the dead will rise up. Furthermore, all those in exile will be brought safely home. Be these acts, the people will know that their God has power over life and death. For Paul and the second reading, when Paul uses the word "flesh", he means that aspect of human nature that is subject to sinfulness and corruptibility. But the life of the spirit has been given to all who believe in the risen Lord. John's story of the raising of Lazarus offers us hope and consolation in the face of death. The grief of Jesus, Martha, and Mary shows us the Lord understands and shares in our human grief at the death of our loved ones. At the same time, Jesus teaches, through the power his Father has given him, he has power over death. Ultimately, he will teach us through his own death and resurrection, we can trust in the promise of eternal life.
