GRASS MOWING BIDS BEING ACCEPTED: St. Elizabeth Fire Protection District is now accepting mowing and weed eating bids. Bid dead line is April 17. Bids should be on a per cutting basis. Grass cutting will not be more than once a week. In case of a drought, it will be at the discretion of the board to cut grass. Time frame will be for the 2023 grass cutting season. Mowing will be considered contract labor, and bidder will have to provide proof of adequate liability insurance. As contract labor, bidder will have to supply his own workman's comp insurance, gas and equipment, and be responsible for employment taxes. 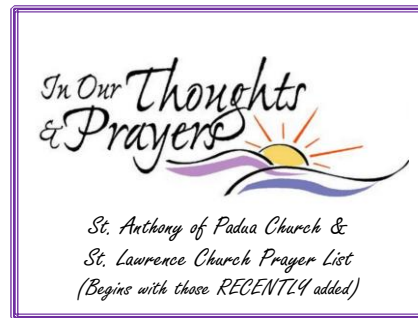

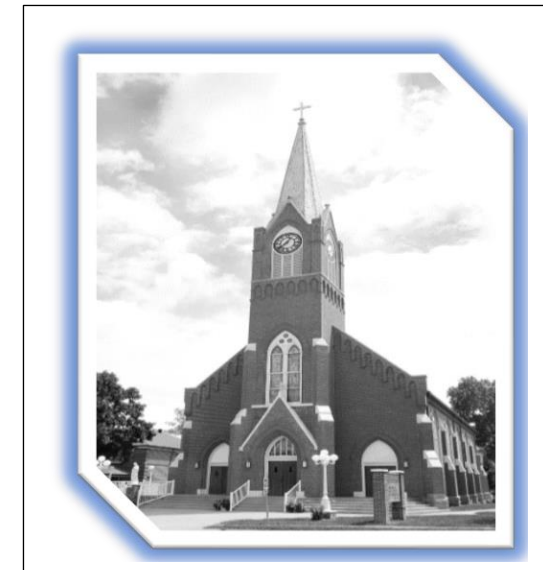
