

Sunday, January 7, 2024 – Epiphany of The Lord: In your high school English class, you might have learned that an "epiphany" is the moment when a character is struck with a life-changing realization that changes the rest of the story. Every good novel has one! That's one way to think about the feast we're celebrating today. God revealed himself to the Gentiles, and that moment changed everything. There had been hints of God welcoming the Gentiles throughout the Old Testament. But Matthew's Gospel shows us this pivotal moment: pagan astrologers from the East came to worship Jesus, the newborn King of the Jews. They are the first of the "nations" whom Isaiah prophesied would walk by the Lord's light (Isaiah 60:3). They are the first of those Paul says will be "coheirs...in Christ Jesus through the gospel". Why is this event so important? Because it reveals to us God's love is far more expansive than anyone had every thought. We begin to see that in Christ, a loving relationship with God is open to everyone who comes to him; Jew or Gentile! That includes YOU! Today, as you celebrate this great feast, give thanks to God who loves so extravagantly that he opens his arms wide to welcome everyone who believes. Pray, too, that all people will come to the Lord.

Over the past few years, with the help of community support, we have been able to replace the baseball backstop & dugouts, install new scoreboards on the baseball and softball fields, and improve the playability of both fields through a new infield mix, laser grading, and new sod. The next major upgrade and undertaking by the Park Board is to improve the softball field dugouts.
