Sunday, June 30, 2024 – Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time: Of course they were astounded! The disciples and the parents of this young girl had just seen Jesus raise her from the dead. Now she was walking around as if she had never been ill. And just a few minutes earlier, a woman suffering from a hemorrhage for 12 long years had been instantly cured just by touching Jesus’ cloak (Mark 5:27-29). Both were amazing displays of power, and both demonstrated that Jesus was no ordinary rabbi. We do know Jesus is the Son of God, and yet, sometimes, we find ourselves doubting His power. *Can He really heal me? Can He really forgive my most shameful sins? Will He one day raise me to new life?* The answer is within you, through God. So believe in Jesus’ power, as Jairus and the woman did. Step out in faith and ask for what you need and keep asking even if you don’t get it. Believe that Jesus, Lord of Heaven and earth, has the power and desire to heal and give new life. This is why He came to earth, and He will do it, in His own perfect time and way.
