CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION – June 22 at St. Lawrence, 10 AM Mass

The words “Corpus Christi” means “Body of Christ” and are another name for the “Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ”. The Solemnity is celebrated on the Sunday after Trinity Sunday and, marks with particular emphasis, the doctrine of Christ’s real presence—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity—in the Eucharist. In celebrating the Solemnity, the Corpus Christi Procession will be held (weather-permitting) at St. Lawrence immediately following the 10:00 AM Mass.

Why should we participate in the Corpus Christi procession? The annual procession on the Feast of Corpus Christi has a special importance and meaning for the pastoral life of the parish and community. When the Eucharist is carried through the street/parish, in a solemn procession with singing, parishioners and people of faith, give public witness of their devotion toward the Sacrament. Please join us!

Processional will include the St. Cecilia Children’s Choir & 2025 First Communicants. We will meet in CHURCH BASEMENT at 9:15 AM for instructions and practice.

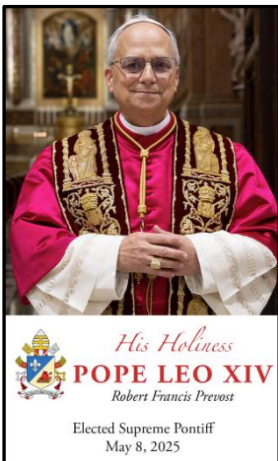
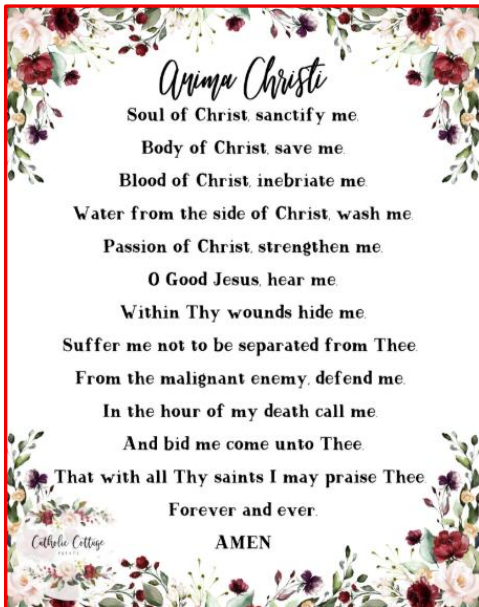
