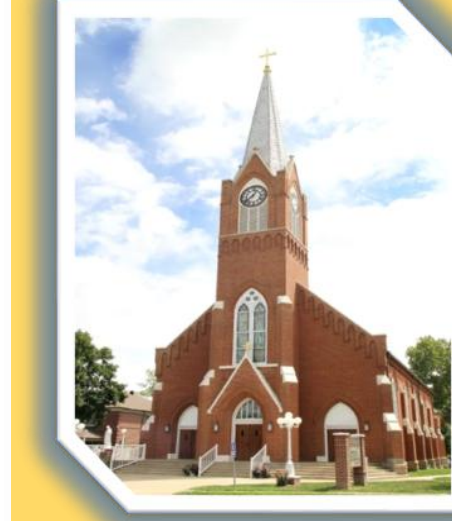

Sunday, June 29, 2025 – Daily Reflection: Today, we celebrate Saints Peter and Paul. While these two apostles couldn't have been more different in personality and background, they have one essential trait in common; both believed and proclaimed the message that Peter declares in today's Gospel: Jesus is "the Christ, the Son of the Living God." In our first reading, we learn how Peter, imprisoned in a heavily guarded jail, kept talking about Jesus and his (Peter) miraculous deliverance from 16 guards. Then in the second reading, Paul speaks some of his last words to Timothy about how Jesus stood by him, giving him strength and rescuing him from danger. This truth that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the Living God, became the very foundation of Peter and Paul's lives. It was the reality that spurred them to keep following the Lord. It motivated them to testify to Jesus before massive crowds, their closest friends, and in front of religious and secular authorities. And it strengthened them as they faced martyrdom for their faith. As you consider these two holy men today, you can almost hear them saying, *"See how Jesus has changed our lives! Who do you say that he is? How does that make a difference in the way you live?"*

"Jesus, I believe you are the Christ! Let this truth become my foundation today and every day!"
