



Sunday, July 27, 2025 – Daily Reflection: Have you ever heard the phrase, "You never know unless you ask"? It's true in so many situations. For example, you might never know if your boss will give you a raise unless you ask. Or you might never know if your friend needs your help unless you ask and offer! In today's Gospel, Jesus tells a parable about a man who hoped that his neighbor would give him some bread to feed his guest. It was late at night, so he wasn't sure. But he would never know unless he asked. SO, he knocked on his neighbor's door and persisted until his neighbor finally got out of bed and gave him what he needed. Jesus told this parable to encourage us to ASK our Heavenly Father for whatever we need. All of us, at some time, have hesitated in asking God for something; perhaps we thought we didn't deserve it or assumed God wouldn't answer us, so why bother trying. OH ye have little faith! Jesus WANTS us to relate to our Father and he knows that God provides everything that we need, so he (Jesus) wants us to approach God with confidence and make our request. Jesus knows that by coming to God with our needs, we not only acknowledge our dependence on him, but we also come to know him and trust him more deeply. Is there something you've been wanting to ask God or is there something you've asked for and have not received? BE PERSISTENT like the man who wasn't shy about knocking at his neighbor's door at midnight. Keep knocking at God's door and trust, that in his time, he WILL give you the bread you need.

Father, you are the give of all good gifts. Help me to be bold and ask for what I need!
